2 THE LODGE, VERBIER, SWITZERLAND

It's a bit of a jet-set hotspot, Verbier (regulars include Richard Branson, Hugh Grant and assorted young royals), and after a recent wave of cool chalet and club openings, it's set to be one of the hottest places in the Alps. The Lodge, Branson's ultra-luxe chalet, comes complete with gym, swimming pool, mini ice rink and much more. It opened in January and proved such a hit, you'll have to be quick to bag a week for this season.

3 FERME DE MOUDON, LES GETS, FRANCE

4 TIVOLI LODGE, DAVOS, SWITZERLAND

Right up at the Rolls-Royce end of the chalet spectrum is Descent, with a reputation for providing the best in everything from food to childcare. One of their top properties is Tivoli Lodge, which looks traditional on the outside but hides a chic, contemporary interior. With its own cinema room and separate spa building, there's plenty of temptation to skive off the slopes for the odd afternoon...
